UNIFORMS

Uniforms are now available for purchase direct from the kindergarten at any time throughout the year. This includes windcheaters, T-shirts and hats. We can accept cash, cheques or money-orders. Please see your Educators for any purchases.

ILLNESSES

We have had a number of children away with various illnesses over the last few weeks. It is important that if your child returns to kindergarten while still taking antibiotics that you let educators know (even if they are not required to have the medication during kinder time). Also any child who has symptoms of vomiting or diarrhoea must not attend Oakhill Kindergarten until at least 24 hours after their last loose bowel motion or last episode of vomiting.

WINTER WOOLLIES

Unless it is raining, children will be going outside during Term 2 and Term 3. As the weather starts to cool, we recommend that children bring a warm coat and hat/beanie. We also ask that you keep vigilant with coughs and colds and keep your children home if they aren't well to save the bugs spreading.
